

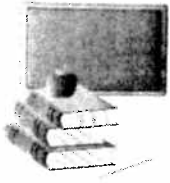


Ms. Bieber's Second Grade Supply List

Please label all of your child's supplies with their name.

- An art shirt with their name on the inside tag
- 2 big boxes of tissues to share with the class
- Small box of crayons (24-48 crayons)
- Pack of colored pencils
- Children's scissors
- Cap erasers
- 6 Glue sticks (no liquid glue)
- 2 blue or black pens
- School box to store pencils
- 2 wide ruled spiral notebooks (1 blue, 1 green - please **NO** perforated edges)
- 4 pocket folders with 3 prong fasteners (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue)
- 48- 70 pencils (sharpened is preferred)
- 2 containers of antibacterial disinfecting wipes
- 1 plastic pocket folder with 3 holes punched (no prongs)
- one 1 inch 3 ring binder that doesn't have pockets or cardboard covers

Please don't buy trapper keepers because they don't fit in the desk. Also, the children have a difficult time getting backpacks with wheels in their cubbies. These create a safety issue when they are left on the floor in the classroom.



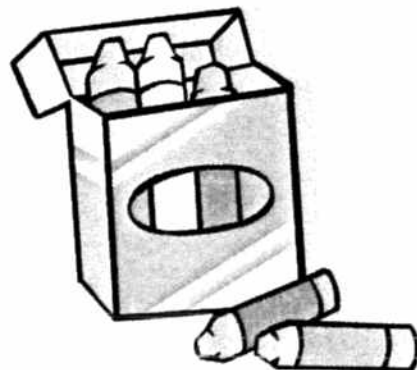
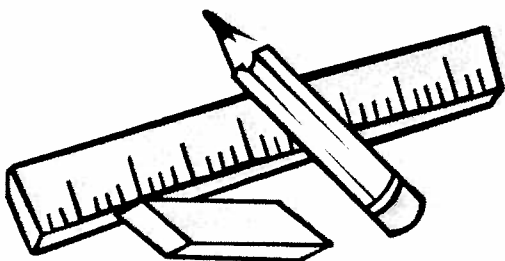

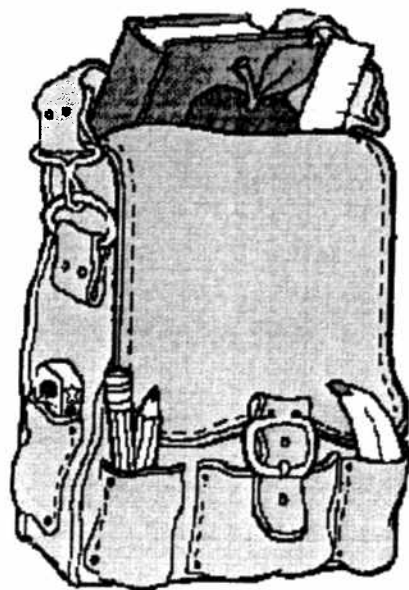
- 2 boxes of pencils (sharpened is preferred)
- cap erasers
- 2 boxes of 24-48 crayons (please, no extra large boxes)
- children's scissors
- 6 glue sticks (please, no liquid glue)
- 1 pencil holder (box or pouch)
- 4 **SOLID colored pocket** folders with **metal clasps** (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue)
- 1 pocket folder that has been **hole punched**
- 1 box of tissues to share
- 2 containers of antibacterial disinfecting wipes
- 1 inch** binder with a hard cover (please be sure it's 1" - not larger or smaller)
- 2 **wide ruled spiral** notebooks (1 blue, 1 green - no perforated edges please)
- 1 notebook **without lines** (just plain white drawing paper)
