Below is a list of supplies you will need for 4th grade. All of these items can be found at local stores. *Please bring ALL of the following items on the FIRST DAY of school.*

- 3 spiral notebooks - 2 yellow and 1 blue
- 10 Pocket folders with 3 prong fasteners - 2 of each color (green, red, blue, orange, purple, yellow)
- 1 ruler (1 - 12 inch)
- ***1 spiral **STENO PAD** notebook (*Wegmans, Staples, Dollar Tree*)**
- Loose leaf paper (2 packages)
- Baby Wipes (one package)
- Tissues (3 CUBE SIZE boxes)
- 1 hard plastic pencil box (no bigger than 8 x 5)



All of the following supplies should fit in the pencil box listed above

- Pencils (3 or more) twelve packs
- Glue sticks (2 or more)
- Highlighters (2)
- Scissors (1)
- Erasers (1) pack of 4
- Crayons or Colored pencils (8-12 colors)
- Pencil sharpener *with a lid/cover* (1)
- Blue and red pens (2 each)

Other supplies we would appreciate for the classroom:

- EXPO markers
- Hand sanitizer
- Paper products (plates, napkins, cups)
- Plastic spoons, knives, forks
- ZIPLOC Baggies (GALLON size, QUART size, Sandwich Size & Snack Size)

Fourth Grade 2009 – 2010 Supply List

We hope you and your family are enjoying a fun and relaxing summer. Listed below are the supplies your child will need for fourth grade when they return in September. Hopefully you'll be able to take advantage of "back to school" sales! We do encourage you to purchase two folders in each color (four of red) while they are on sales, because we find that folders do need to be replaced mid-year when required colors can be difficult to find. Fourth grade teachers will store them at school for your child until they are needed.
